Abstract The design of our urban fabric has until now contemplated the issues around infrastructure, growth and prosperity in the modern metropolis. But now as the city becomes the natural habitat for the human population, issues such as mental and physical health as well as climate resilience are emerging as the big issue around urban living. How to make Future Cities more liveable, adaptable and self-sufficient through intelligent water management and the adoption of WSUD (Water Sensitive Urban Design) will be the topic of Peter's discussion.

Peter Wilder is a principal of Wilder Associates and an Associate of the Building Research Establishment, and a policy advisor to the UK Green Building Council and the Landscape Institute.
